


# Publish Your CUHK Client Certificate to MS Exchange Server on Outlook

(This user guide is applicable to Outlook 2010 or above)



 From the Options window, select Trust Centre and then Trust CenterSettings




3. From **Trust Centre** under **E-mail Security**, you should see your client cert by default. If not, click Settings to select your cert.
