



Install CUHK Root CA Certificate on Firefox

(This user guide is applicable to Firefox 33 or above)

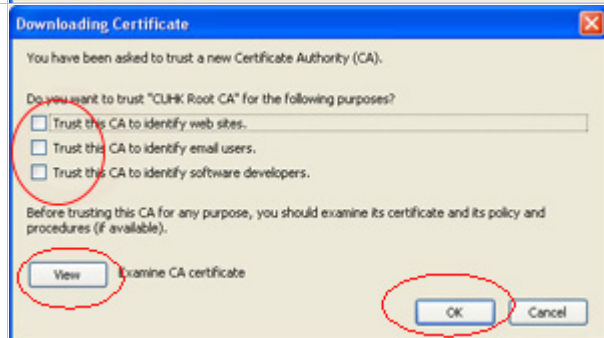
1. Open a Firefox and click [here](#) to download CUHK root certificate. A **Downloading Certificate** dialog box will be prompted as found on the right figure.

Click **View** to ensure that the CUHK root certificate was issued by "The Chinese University of Hong Kong".

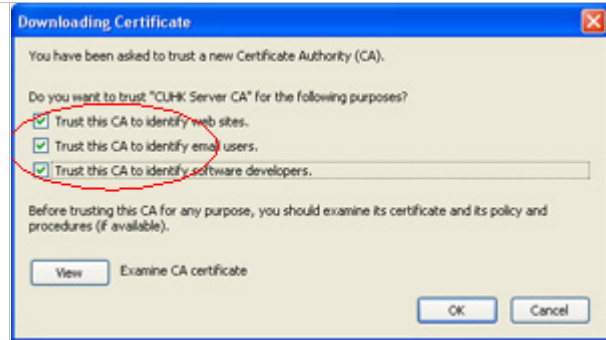


2. When you are prompted to trust "CUHK Root CA" with the following options,
 - Trust this CA to identify web sites
 - Trust this CA to identify email users
 - Trust this CA to identify software developers.

Check all the boxes and click OK.

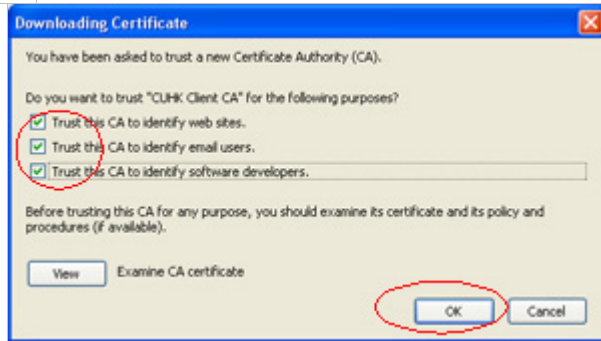


3. When you are prompted to trust "CUHK Server CA" with the following options,
- Trust this CA to identify web sites
 - Trust this CA to identify email users
 - Trust this CA to identify software developers.



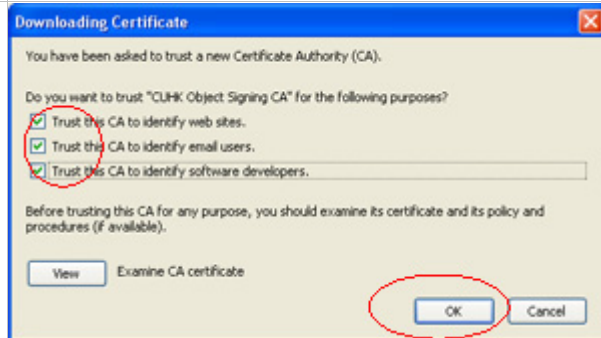
Check all the boxes and click OK.

4. When you are prompted to trust "CUHK Client CA" with the following options,
- Trust this CA to identify web sites
 - Trust this CA to identify email users
 - Trust this CA to identify software developers.

5. When you are prompted to trust "CUHK Object CA" with the following options,
- Trust this CA to identify web sites
 - Trust this CA to identify email users
 - Trust this CA to identify software developers.



Check all the boxes and click OK.

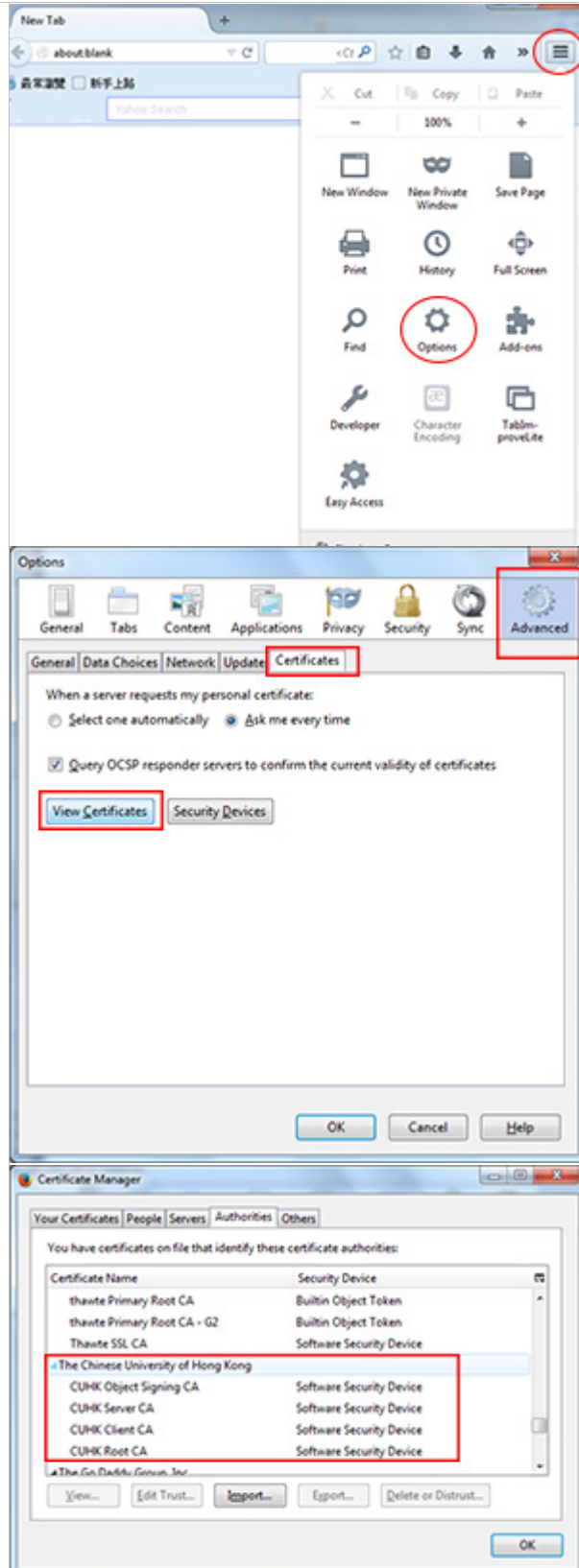


6. To check whether the CUHK Root CA certificate has been successfully installed:

Launch a Firefox > click **Open Menu** > **Options** > **Advanced** > **Certificates** > **View Certificates**.

Under **Authorities**, you should see below certificates installed.

- CUHK Object Signing CA
- CUHK Client CA
- CUHK Server CA
- CUHK Root CA
