




Install CUHK Root CA Certificate on Internet Explorer

(This user guide is applicable to IE 10 or above)


1. Download the CUHK root certificate from [here](#) with Internet Explorer and save to "Downloads".

2. Click **Tools** menu > **Internet options**.






3. Click Content tab > Certificates.





- 4. Click **Trusted Root Certification Authorities** and **Import** to invoke the **Certificate Import Wizard**






5. Click **Next**






6. Select the file name with type **PKCS #7 Certificates**






7. The combined.p7b file will display.

Select the **combined.p7b** file and click **Open** to proceed.





8. Click **Next** to continue.






9. Select


Place all certificates in the following store:

Click **Next**






10. Click **Finish** to complete the import process.





11. If the CUHK Root CA root certificate has not been added yet, system will prompt you to do so.

Click **Yes** to proceed.




12. The system will notify you **The import was successful**. Click **OK**.





13. To check the imported CUHK Root CA Certificate, select **Trusted Root Certification Authorities** tab from Certificates window. You will see the CUHK Root CA Certificate listed there.

Click **Close** after checking.
