



Install CUHK VPN on Android

(This user guide is applicable to Android 5.0 or above)

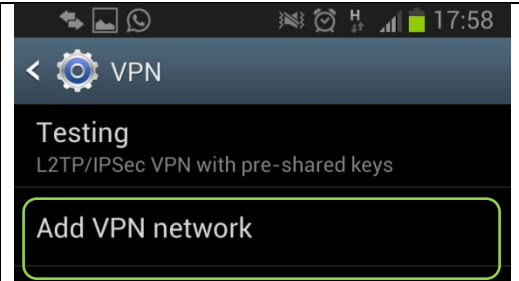
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A. Add CUHK VPN Profile

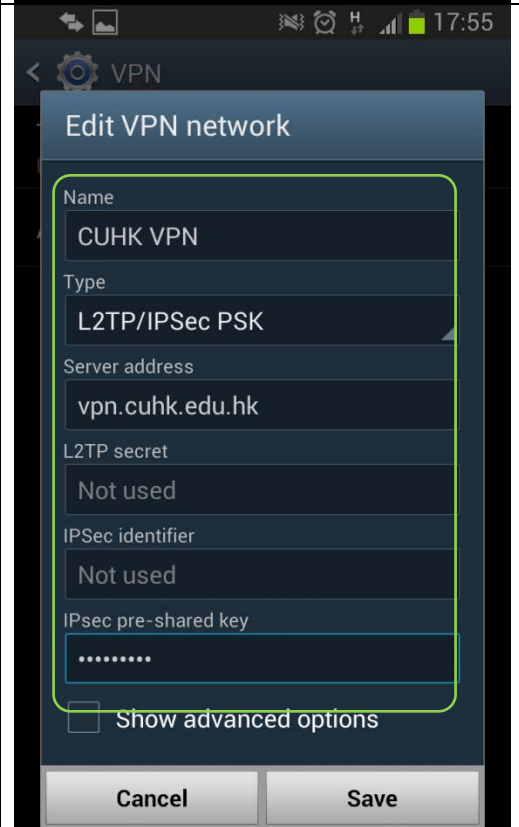
3. Click **Add VPN network** to add a new VPN profile.



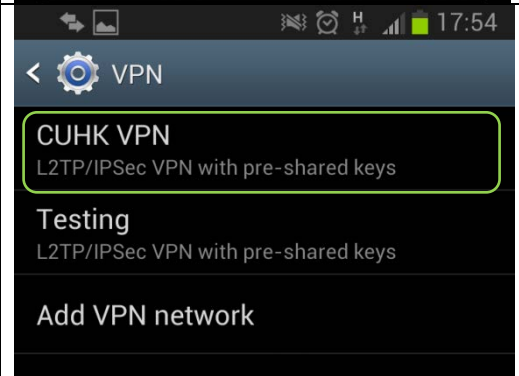
4. Enter the VPN configuration information:




Click **Save**.






5. A new VPN profile **CUHK VPN** will be listed under the VPN menu.
