




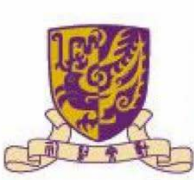


# Connect to CUHK1x with a Mac

(This user guide is applicable to OS X 10.7 or above)

## Detect WiFi Signal of CUHK1x and connect to CUHK1x

<p>1. click  at the top menu bar.
