







# Connect to CUHK1x with a Windows PC / Notebook

(This user guide suits Windows 10 the best and is applicable to Windows 7/8 with slight difference.)

## Detect WiFi Signal of CUHK1x and connect to CUHK1x

<p>1. If you have a hardware WiFi switch on your device, make sure it is turned on.</p> <p>Click the <b>Wi-Fi icon</b>  on the taskbar.</p>	
<p>2. Select <b>CUHK1x</b> from the available wireless networks.</p>	

<p>3. Choose <b>Connect automatically</b> and then Click <b>Connect</b>. Then, you will be automatically connected to <b>CUHK1x</b> next time when a signal is detected.</p>	
<p>4. You will see the following screen. Enter your <b>CUHK email address*</b> for username and your <b>OnePass (CWEM) password</b>. Then, click <b>OK</b>.</p> <p>*Username:  <b>*Students:</b> <i>Student-ID@link.cuhk.edu.hk</i>  E.g. 1155xxxxx@link.cuhk.edu.hk</p> <p><b>Staff:</b> <a href="mailto:Staff-alias@cuhk.edu.hk">Staff-alias@cuhk.edu.hk</a> for staff  E.g. chantaiman@cuhk.edu.hk</p>	
<p>5. Click <b>Connect</b> to continue connecting.</p> <p>Be patient to wait for successful connection.</p>
