A. Detect a Y5ZONE Hotspot Connection

1. Turn on the Wi-Fi function of your computer (please refer to your computer's user manual for more details)

- Click at the top **menu bar** . You will see a list of available wireless networks.

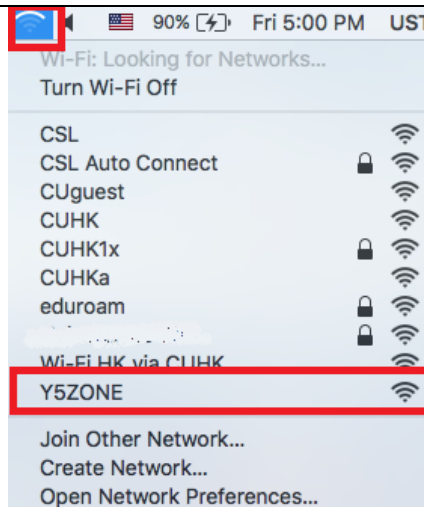
OR

- Open **System Preference** -> **Network**

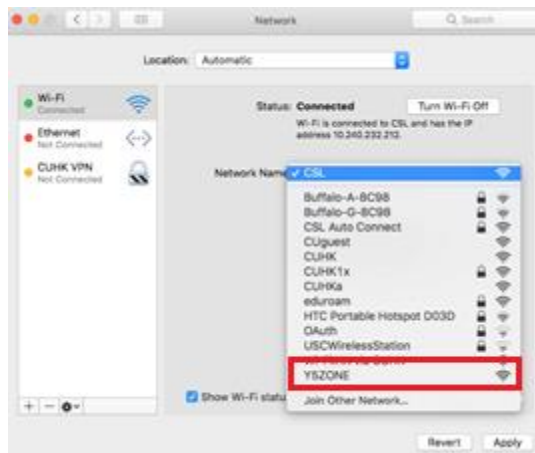
You should see the available wireless networks in the list.

Click **Refresh network list** if you cannot find **Y5Zone** in the list.

Choose **Y5Zone** and then click **Connect**.

1. Open your browser and visit any homepage e.g. <http://www.cuhk.edu.hk>.

Your browser will automatically lead you to the login page below.

2. At the "login" page,
 - Username:

or
Staff: b123456@cuhk.edu.hk
 - Password:
the password you have created for this programme

Click **Login**.

3. If your browser displays "You are now connected to the Internet!" then you may enjoy Y5ZONE Wi-Fi service from now on.
